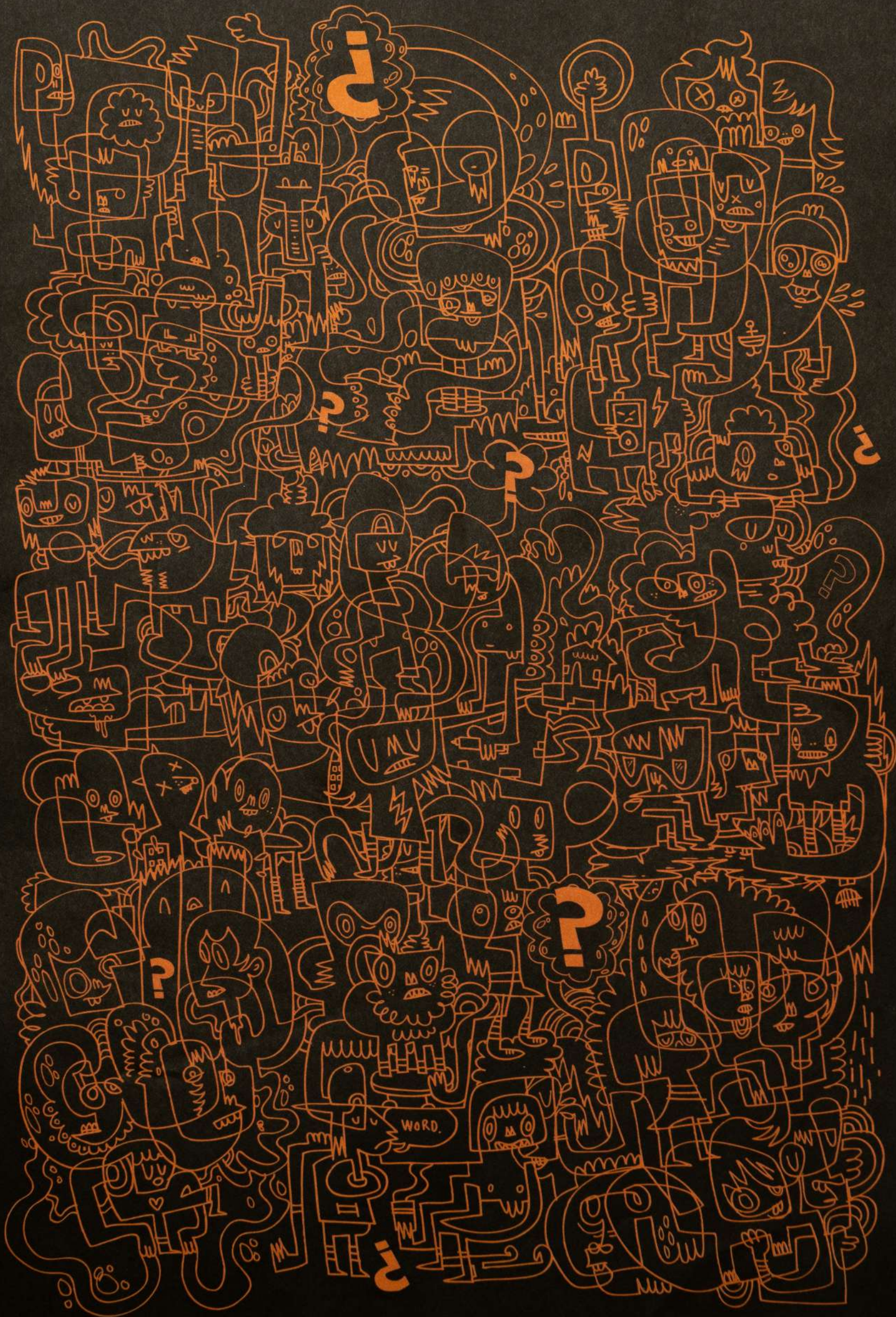

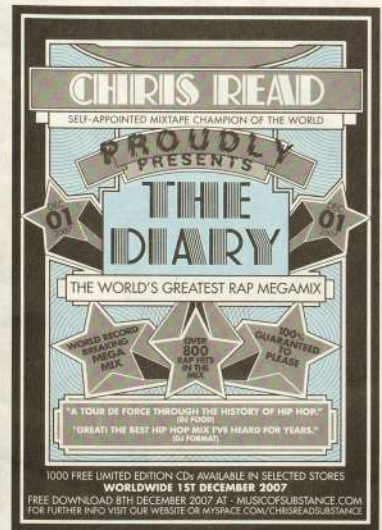

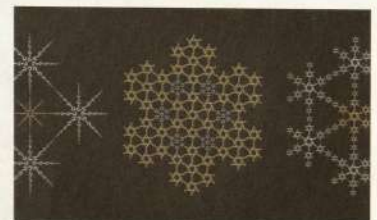

Puma and Scott Bourne teamed up for this early introduction of the Puma S, a clean and classic skate silhouette that takes inspiration from the PUMA Suede and Clyde, the shoe of choice for street skaters in the early 1990's.

Scott, a well-established professional skater and creative force in the writing community, took some time to customize the shoe with his words, sketches and personality. He wrote a poem that is featured on the lining, sketched the "Follow No One" piece on the tongue label and crafted the heel piece with his longtime 'hourglass' logo that has stayed with him throughout his skateboarding career.

Each pair of shoes also features customized tissue paper of Scott's drawings and a photo of Scott skating in Paris. 100 pairs of the shoes will contain a photo signed by the man himself.

The Puma S is available in 3 colourways, red, black and grey. Each shoe comes with 3 sets of fat, durable laces with the bleeding heart logo on a grey metal aglet so you can flip the flaces to your desired look.

We caught up with Scott to find out more about his skateboarding and the inspirations behind the Puma S:

Where are you from?

Originally I am from the ole North State...North Carolina.

Where do you call home now?

I spend a lot of time on the road but I keep an apartment in Paris and spend a couple of months out of the year in San Francisco where I actually lived for 10 years.

How did you get into skating?

My brother and I first got boards when I was 5 and he was 7. Back then we took turns pulling one another behind a bicycle with a rope and doing down hill, sailboat style. Small fiber flew boards. I didn't get a real 'Pro' board until I was about 12 or 13 when my family started to take vacations to the Outer Banks. My brother and I had gotten into surfing. When we were not at the beach we began skating more seriously. I mean looking for concrete, ditches or pools, or crappy spillways. This is when we first started to build ramps or meet other kids who had them.

After that...I was hooked. My brother went more surf. Then went on into the Coast Guard. I went skate, and ran away to California. He now lives in the islands on a 40-foot sailboat. I tour the world on a skateboard. Crazy!

Any memories from back in the day skating in PUMAS?

We rode PUMA Suedes and 'The Clyde' long before any skate shoe. You couldn't get Vans in Carolina at the time so we rode whatever worked best on our boards. At the time this was Chuck Taylor's shoe or Walt's...and Walt's just lasted longer and looked cooler. Back then it was the biggest shoe to hit the market...fat laces and suede brushes. All of a sudden a group of misfit kids that rode skateboards were setting trends right along with rap and punk rock.

How did this project come about?

I had a couple of ideas and I just started to present them to people that I thought would be into them. The truth of the matter is that since 1966 there hasn't been a single sneaker company to break into the sneaker industry without skateboarding. That's how strong the influence has been. I thought that PUMA should have a shoe that really catered to skateboarders...next thing you know I had this opportunity to do something with PUMA skate and we just went for it. That's the reason why I wanted to design my shoe after the shoe that all the skate companies designed their 'original' skate shoes after.

I mean every skate shoe brand has their own rip off of The Clyde. Why? 'Cause it's the best shoe ever to skate in. It was only natural that I follow in the footsteps of Clyde and simply try to beef up the shoe he designed for big jumps and great grip for even bigger jumps and harder landings, and we just didn't see a way to improve on the original sole...The truth is...it's Clyde's shoe.

What's the shoe poem all about?

I wrote the poem long before the shoe idea came up. It was basically about being poor and going to school in worn out shoes, or shoes that were just too small for you and I compared this scenario to tattooing. How I have simply grown out of something I am still forced to wear. I have moved on and moved up. It is simply supposed to give people the opportunity to think something that I could not or would not at the time. I had the idea to include it in

the shoe somehow just to represent the direction I am headed now. I am not just that tattooed maniac on a skateboard with the go for broke attitude any longer. I mean I still am but I am on to other things as well. One of those being writing. The poem will also be in a book of poems I have coming out later in '07 entitled "Cheating On the Metronome".

What's the name of your soon to be published novel...how's things on this front?

At the moment my first book entitled 'A Room With No Windows' is in the hands of my editor Jennifer Friar. Once all the clean up work is done we will start the serious look for a home for the novel. I wrote the original text on paper and it took quite some time to get it in a computer. Now we are doing the clean up work.

What does the hourglass graphic represent?

I first put it on a Consolidated board nearly 10 years ago. At that time it had no wings. It simply meant 'Memento Mori'...Latin for 'Remember You Must Die'. To me it was about chasing time, making every moment count. Each breath, each heart beat! Later I would put it on several things along the way and simply adopt it as mine. Finally after moving to Europe...it would acquire wings. In the old world it is very common to see the hourglass with wings on tomb stones of which in Latin represents the meaning 'Tempest Fugit'...which means 'Time is a fugitive' or 'Time flies'.

It all seemed to work and added to this problem I have had my entire life with time. I feel obsessed to live because I don't know when death is coming to claim me but I do know he will come. In a way it has just become my little symbol and it worked perfectly on the shoe. I wanted to put my mark on the shoe but I just didn't want it to be over done. The hourglass worked perfect.

Any encouraging words?

Yea...follow no one...be who you are and never back down to that man! Believe in your ideas no matter how crazy they may seem to others!

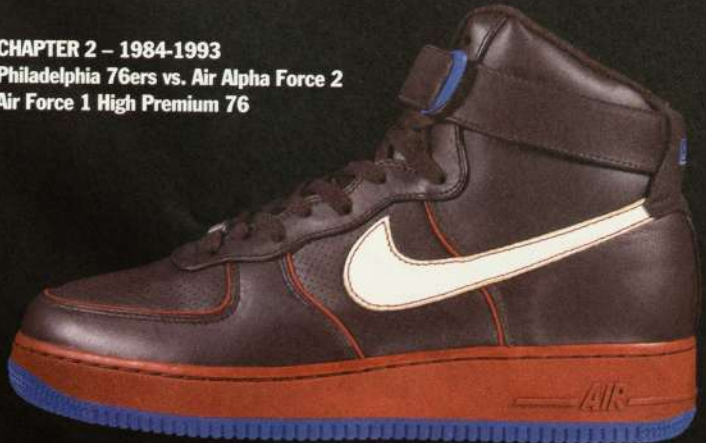
